- Protect your pet – 8-ft. leash (6 ft. in Cuyahoga Valley National Park)
- Take breaks to the side of the trail
- Slow down
- Stay single file
- Do not block the trail
- All Yield to horses

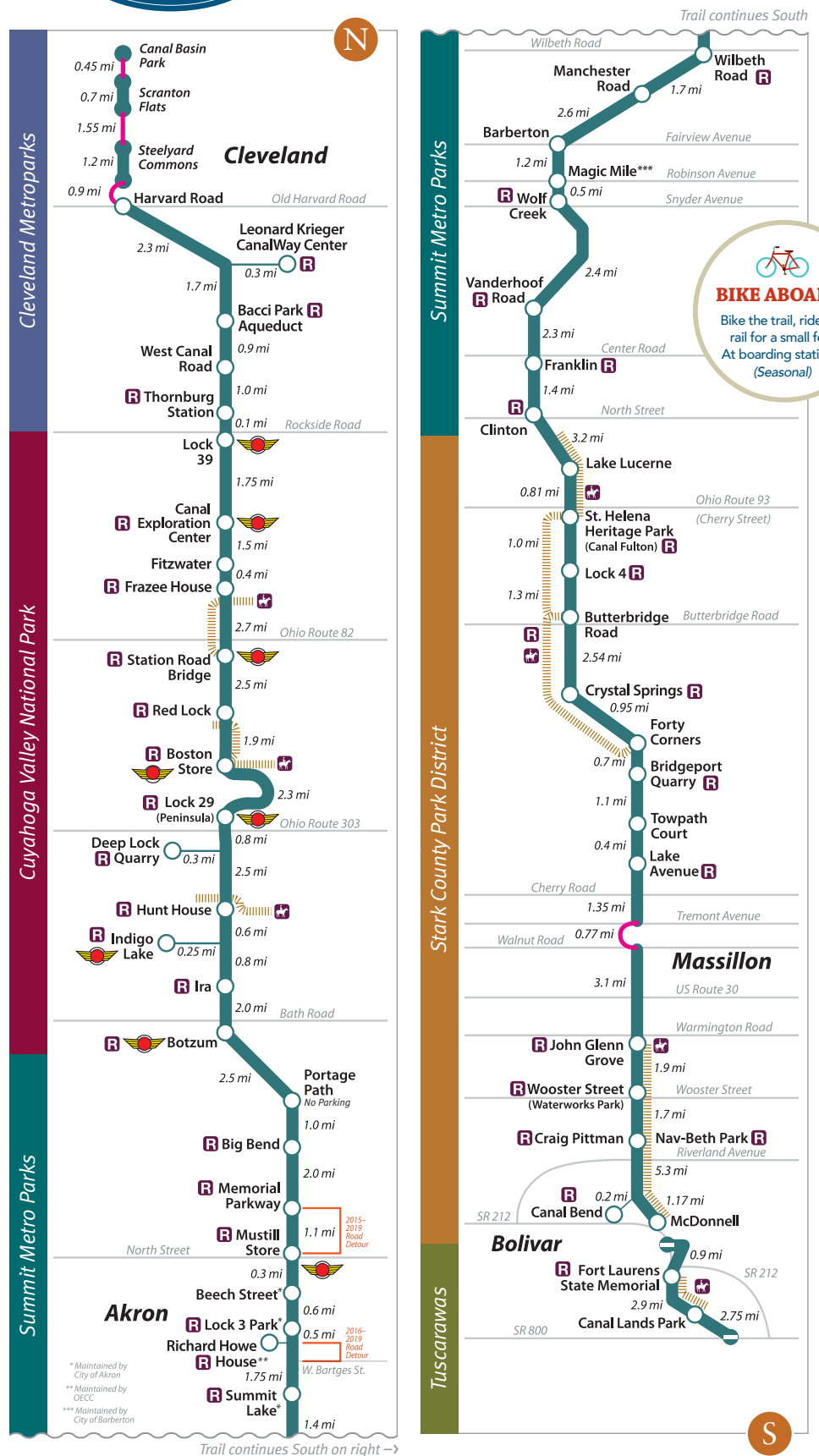
